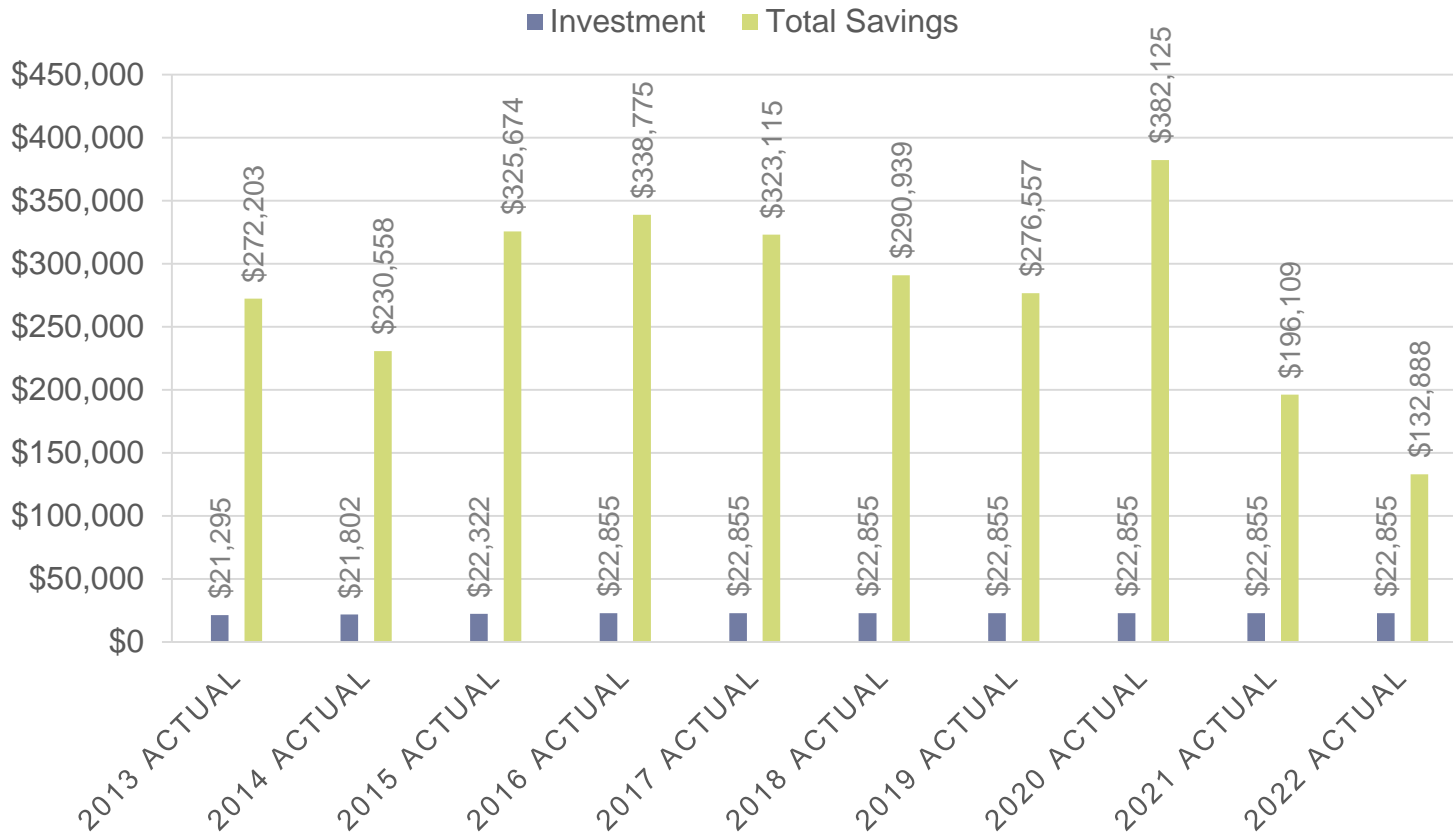
Tracking energy costs and opportunities to save energy are key for this program.

- All employees are accountable for success

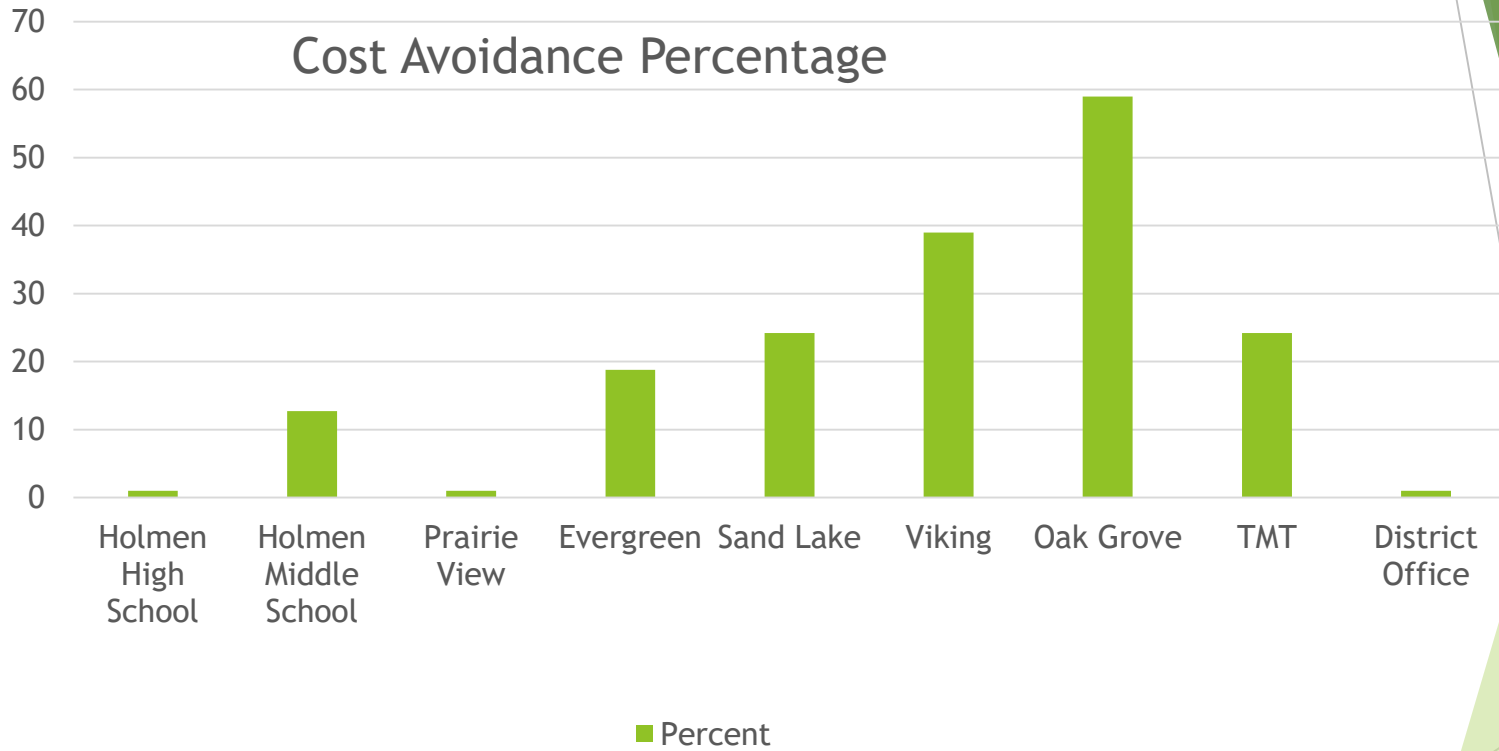
