Reading

 Identifies story elements (characters, setting and events) in a story or main ideas and key details in a nonfiction text

Writing

- Writes and illustrates to share likes and/or dislikes
- Writes and illustrates informational how-to texts
- Writes and illustrates real and/or imagined stories

Speaking & Listening

- Participates in conversations by speaking and listening
- Asks and answers questions about what a speaker says

- Prints upper- and lowercase letters
- Writes a letter to represent sounds

Foundational Skills

- Understands the organization and basic features of print
- Uses phonics and word learning skills (i.e., rhyming, syllables, letter/sound correspondence)

Counting & Cardinality

- Counts to 100 by 1s
- Counts to 100 by 10s
- Counts to answer "How many?" within 20
- Compares groups of objects or numerals 1-10

Operations and Algebraic Thinking

- Understands addition as putting together and adding to
- Understands subtraction as taking apart and taking from
- Adds fluently up to 5
- Subtracts fluently up to 5

Number & Operations in Base Ten

 Understands a teen number is a group of 10 ones and extra ones (18 = 10 + 8)

Geometry

- Identifies and describes 2D shapes (squares, circles, triangles, rectangles, hexagons)
- Identifies and describes 3D shapes (cubes, cones, cylinders, spheres)
- Uses positional words, such as above and below, to describe objects in the environment

Measurement & Data

Describes and compares measurable attributes such as length and weight

Mathematical Practices

Verbally explains mathematical thinking

Science

- Demonstrates an understanding of how to investigate
- Demonstrates an understanding of living and nonliving content
- Demonstrates an understanding of weather

Social Studies

Demonstrates knowledge of concepts/vocabulary

Demonstrates knowledge of concepts/vocabulary

- Demonstrates understanding of art skills and concepts to produce original words of art
- Shows initiative to complete quality work

- Differentiates between singing and speaking voices
- Demonstrates a steady beat
- Demonstrates creative and rhythmic body movements
- Demonstrates knowledge of basic musical form
