School Cafeteria Meal Component Substitutions

The Holmen School District will provide substitute meal components to accommodate students with handicapping conditions meeting the definition of a disability as defined in USDA regulations. Parent/guardian must have a Certification of Disability for Special Dietary Needs Form completed by a licensed physician to request such an accommodation.

Fluid Milk Substitution/Alternative for Students with Non-Disabilities

The Holmen School District will provide fluid milk substitutes/alternatives to accommodate students with medical or other special dietary needs that do not rise to the level of a disability. The District will only offer Lactaid (Lactose Free Milk) or Pearl Soy Milk as substitutions in these cases. To request an accommodation the parent/guardian must submit a written statement identifying the student's medical or other special dietary need. Statements will be accepted from a parent/guardian or from a recognized medical authority.

Only milk substitutes/alternatives that meet the USDA requirements can be served by the district child nutrition program.
