<u>Prescription and Over-the Counter Medications:</u> Medicines such as cough drops, pain relievers, and other other-the-counter remedies to be administered at school require the completion of a School Medication/Treatment Form by a parent/guardian before the medications can be administered. A parent must sign the form, and if it is a prescription, the doctor must sign it, as well. Forms may be obtained from the health office, the district webpage, or from your healthcare provider. All medications must be in the original container and labeled with the child's name. <u>ALL</u> medications must be brought to the health office by an adult, they cannot be transported with students.

<u>Vision Screenings</u>: Vision screenings will be done for 4K, kindergarten, 1st, 3rd and 5th graders. We hope to have the Lion's Club return again this year to help complete the vision screenings. Vision and/or hearing problems can affect a student's educational success and their ability to learn. Parents/guardians or teachers may request screenings for any student at any time during the school year if concerns arise. If you have questions please contact the health office.

CHILD FIND – Holmen's Early Childhood Developmental Screening

Do you have a child who is 2 ½ -5 years old and lives in the Holmen School District?

The School District of Holmen offers Child Find, which is a free, universal development screening for all children between the ages of 2 ½ -5 years old. All information shared is confidential and only viewed by professional educators in our district.

Purpose of the Early Childhood Screening:

Specialists in the early childhood field will review information regarding:

- Typical development
- Child's level of development (based on questionnaires completed by guardians)
- Services and resources available in the community for families and young children
- Any questions or concerns parents may have pertaining to their child

When does the screening take place?

Screenings will be completed on an individual basis through developmental questionnaires. Early Childhood specialists will review your responses, as well as provide support and complete screenings when applicable (virtually or in-person).

** Please note, this is not mandatory for 4K or 5K enrollment, but is highly encouraged for children over 2 ½ years, whether or not you have concerns regarding your child's development.

Your child is growing and learning at an amazing pace! They have been working hard to learn the routine and expectations of their classroom, learn, play and build friendships. In the Holmen Public Preschool program, we teach our students positive expectations for all parts of their day while at school to help them be safe, respectful and responsible. This is all part of our Pyramid Model approach, which is a framework we use to ensure multilevel systems of behavioral support. We also put into place support for students who are still learning how to be safe, respectful and responsible.

Below are a couple of examples of how we recognize individuals and the whole group when we see them being safe, respectful and responsible.

- Individual Celebration Bucket Filler Stickers: These stickers highlight your child being safe, responsible or respectful while at school. Enjoy celebrating with your child when they get a bucket filler!
- Whole Class/Group Celebration: When your child's entire class demonstrates safe, respectful or responsible behaviors they may earn a token to place in the class bucket! When the bucket/jar is filled, the class gets to have a celebration of their positive behaviors!

While Pyramid Model is one of the ways in which we support this development, the teachers will also introduce puppets to the children as a component of our social-emotional curriculum called, Second Step. The puppets help teach the students about emotions, behaviors, and solutions to problems they may encounter. Then, the children are tasked with using the strategy introduced during their play and interactions with classmates and staff.

In addition, the Holmen Public Preschool staff will introduce The Zones of Regulation to students later this year. Watch for more information about The Zones of Regulation to come.

Throughout the school year, we will be providing updates regarding the WI Pyramid Model framework and what we are working on with students.

Text Message Notification System

The School District of Holmen also utilizes a text message notification system to provide notifications to families and staff regarding delays and closings due to inclement weather, as well as other emergencies. If you have a student enrolled in the School District of Holmen and would like to receive these text messages, **text "YES" to 87569.**

Important Reminders

If school is delayed for two hours or more, there will be NO morning Early Childhood/4K. If school is dismissed two hours or more early, there will be NO afternoon Early Childhood/4K.

Some circumstances require driver discretion, even though schools may be running. A parent needs to exercise their parental responsibilities and not allow their children to ride if indeed they believe the conditions are too treacherous.

Virtual Backpack

The School District of Holmen utilizes a "green" approach for distributing flyers from community organizations, and has discontinued the process of sending paper flyers in your student's backpack, unless they are school related. The information is divided into three sections, by grade levels, and updated on a regular basis.

Activities to Encourage Speech and Language Development

2 to 4 years

- Speak clearly to your child. Model good speech.
- Repeat what your child says to show that you understand. Add on to what they say. Use words like, "Want juice? I have juice. I have apple juice. Do you want apple juice?"
- It's okay to use baby talk sometimes. Be sure to use the adult word too. For example, "It is time for din-din. We will have dinner now."
- Cut out pictures of favorite or familiar things. Put them into categories, like things to ride on, things to eat, and things to play with. Make silly pictures by mixing and matching pictures. Glue a picture of a dog behind the wheel of a car. Talk about what is wrong with the picture and ways to "fix" it.
- Help your child understand and ask questions. Play the yes—no game. Ask questions such as, "Are you Marty?" and "Can a pig fly?" Have your child make up questions and try to fool you.
- Ask questions that include a choice. "Do you want an apple or an orange?" "Do you want to wear your red shirt or your blue shirt?"
- Help your child learn new words. Name body parts, and talk about what you do with them. "This is my nose. I can smell flowers, brownies, and soap."
- Sing simple songs, and say nursery rhymes. This helps your child learn the rhythm of speech.
- Place familiar objects in a box. Have your child take one out and tell you its name and how to use it. "This is
 my ball. I bounce it. I play with it."
- Show pictures of familiar people and places. Talk about who they are and what happened. Try making up new stories.
