School District of Holmen MVR Qualification Standards: Alternate Vehicle Drivers

In an attempt to consistently review the Motor Vehicle Records of potential driving candidates for the School District of Holmen (as it relates to standards used by the State of Wisconsin Motor Vehicle Department), the following guidelines will be utilized. Although discretion may be exhibited by the reviewer, listed below is the minimum of acceptability.

Utilizing School District of Holmen Driver Standards:

A potential alternate vehicle driving candidate must meet the following standards:

- Minimum age of 19 years old and
- Safe driving record

<u>Utilizing the Violations Listed Per WI Department of Motor Vehicle Department:</u>

A potential vehicle driving candidate will be rejected for the following MVR record:

- If there are more than 6 total points of violations within the past one year*, or
- If there are more than 9 total points of violations within the past three years, or
- If there are more than 4 offenses of any type within three years, or
- If there are any 6 point individual violations within the past five years
- For any district driver involved in <u>transporting students</u> -- If there has been an **OWI (or DUI) violation within the past ten years**.

Upon review, any out-of-state violations will be given the same point equivalent as is used by the State of Wisconsin.
