


Referendum Question

Shall the School District of Holmen be allowed to exceed the revenue limit specified in § 121.91, Wis. Stats., by up to \$450,000 per year commencing with the 2019-2020 school year and continuing through the 2023-2024 school year on a non-recurring basis for the purpose of modernizing and maintaining a capable technology infrastructure, and providing information technology services and devices across the District?

Tax Impact

There will be no net increase in the current school property tax rate.

2015 Referendum: Building the Framework

- \$655,00/year for 4 years ending June 2019
- Launched 1:1 Mobile Device Program at HS & MS
 - o 2,000 Chromebooks deployed to students
- Hired two technology staff members to support
 1:1 Mobile Device Program
- Built wireless network infrastructure

2019 Referendum: Sustaining the Technology

- \$450,000/year for 5 years ending June 2024
- Purchase & refresh of mobile devices including Chromebooks, iPads, etc.
- Upkeep & replacement of classroom technology
- Upkeep & upgrades to District network
- Repair of District-owned devices used by students
- Retain current level of technology staffing
