- My spouse attends the meetings.
- I don't know about the meetings in time to plan.
- Not sure I have time for the additional obligation.
- I'm in too many things now
- New to the school/district
- So many other commitments at this time
- Don't know what actually happens during meeting, assume it's just a report out plus volunteer requests.

What would increase your likelihood of attending? Other responses:

- Never been so I don't have an opinion on this at this time.
- Keep meetings at 20 minute duration.
- Having a posted agenda of what the meeting will be about.
- Knowing that I can just attend a meeting as an observer that I wouldn't necessarily have to volunteer or commit my time to any projects
- Knowing the agenda ahead of time would be interesting.
- I haven't been to a full session so I wouldn't know
