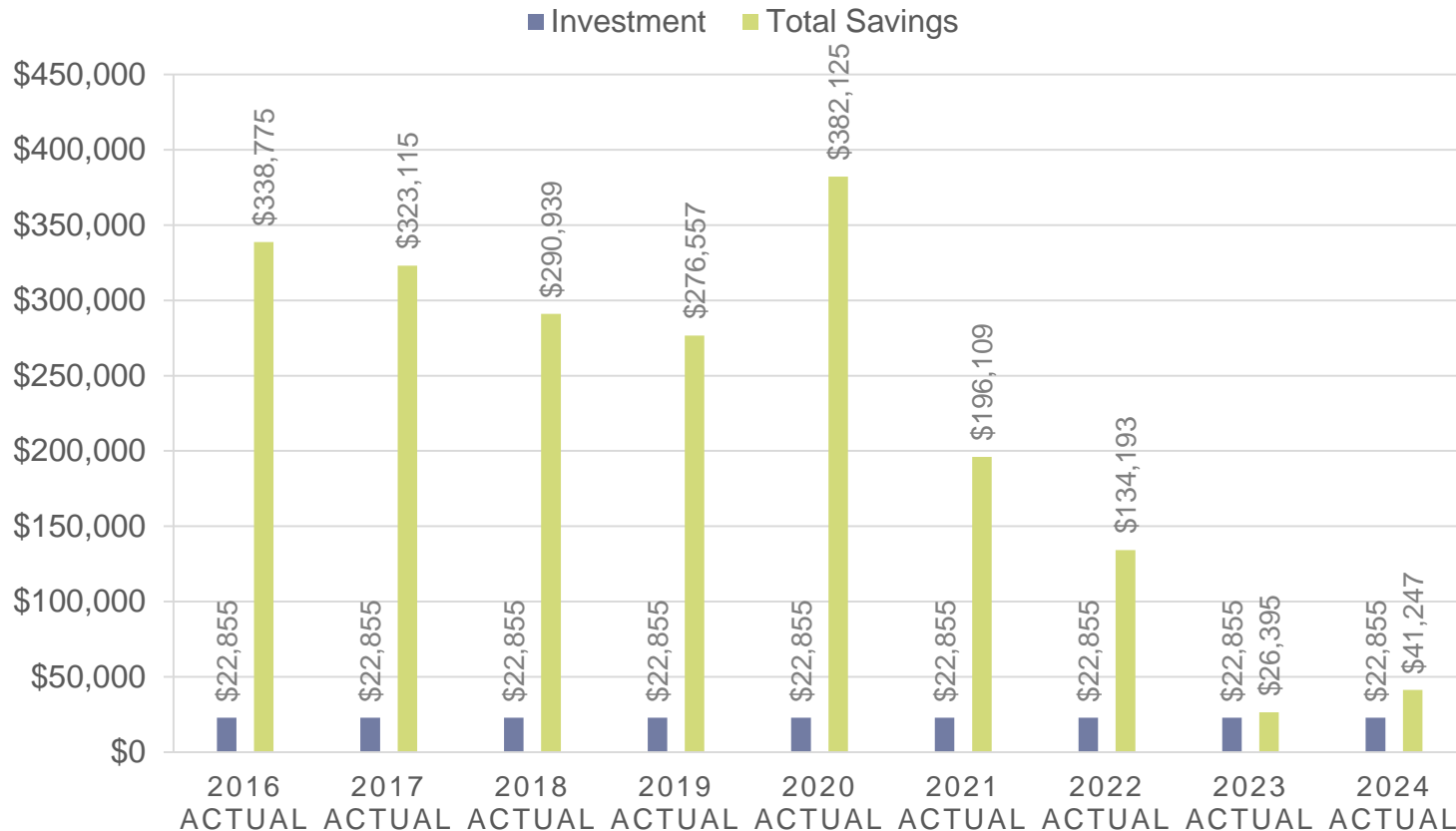
Tracking energy costs and opportunities to save energy are key for this program.

School District of Holmen Energy Conservation Program: Savings vs. Investment



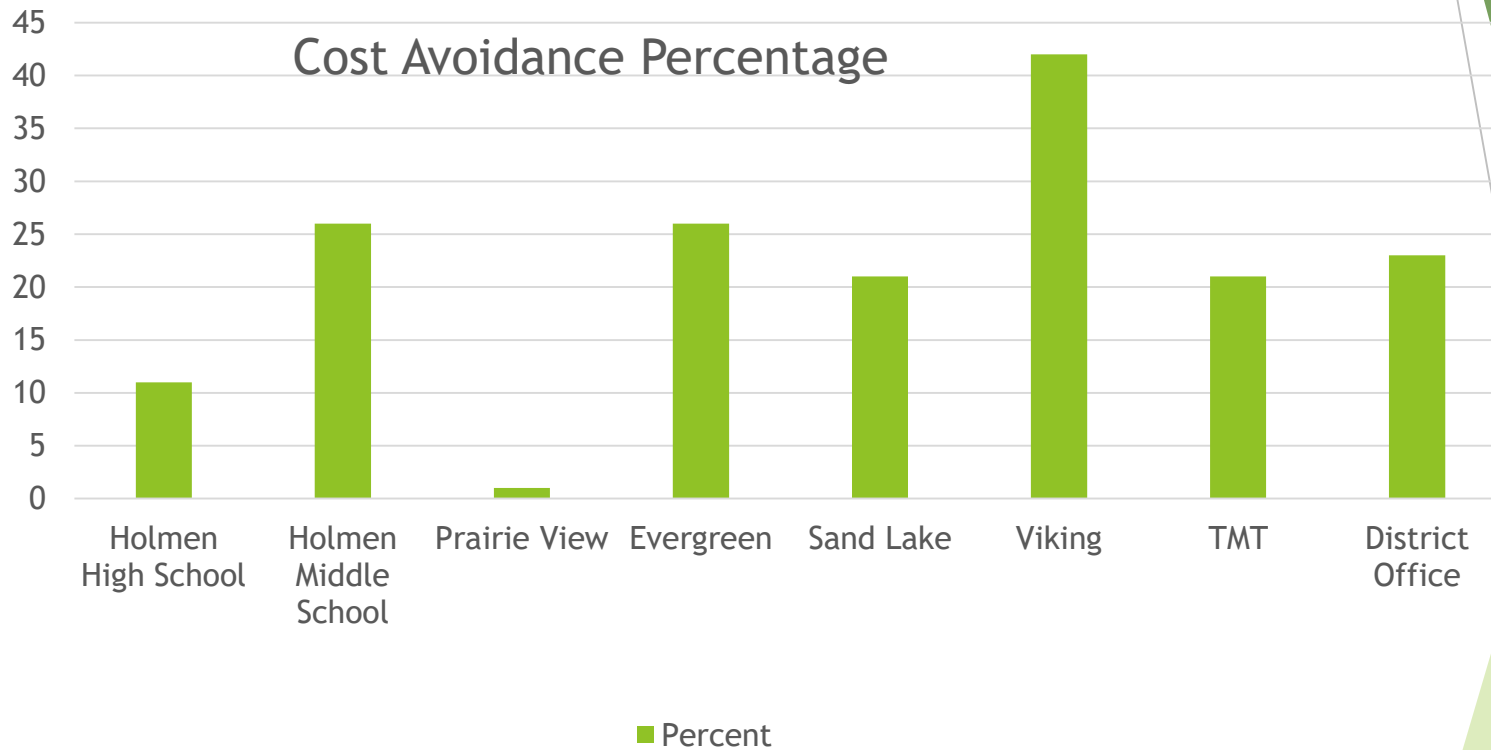
- The energy conservation program pays long-term dividends
