# HOLMen MIDDLe SCHOOL APRIL 2024 VIKING UPDATES

I hope you and your family had a great break and enjoyed spending time together. I enjoyed some time away with my family, but I always look forward to returning to school with our students. Over break, we started some of our building work in preparation for construction to start at HMS this summer. Here is some information about the work that has been completed and is to come:

- On Friday, March 15, we set up a pilot classroom with different types of furniture that we could have in our classrooms when the renovation is complete. Classes have had the opportunity to go to this room and give feedback about the furniture they would like in their new classrooms.
- During the week of March 18, a power pole was put up on the north end of the basketball courts, which will provide power to the construction trailers that were set up over break.
- Once students and staff left the building for the break on Friday, March 22, construction crews began the asbestos abatement work in our 6th grade (north) wing. Part of
  this work was removing the lockers so our 6th graders will navigate HMS without lockers for the remainder of the school year. We thank them for their flexibility.
- On Monday, April 22, we will begin putting gravel down in the grass area where outdoor recess currently takes place. This will be the staging area for our construction
  project over the next year and a half.
  - We will work with our students to find a different location for recess or outdoor activities outside during this time.
- Monday, May 24, Field A outside will be off limits for the entire summer due to reseeding.
- On Tuesday, May 28, Gym B will be closed to prepare for the storage of building furniture and classroom materials. It will not be able to be used until the 2025 2026 school year.
- On Monday, June 3, Gym A will be closed to prepare for renovations and updates that will take place over the summer of 2024.
- On Friday, June 7, construction begins on the entire remodel of the 6th grade (north) end.

Throughout the summer and duration of the project, our goal is to keep our families and community updated on the progress and next steps of the construction project. Once a month, we look forward to sharing a video update facilitated by one of our HMS students with different construction personnel. The video will be a fun way to keep you all updated on the progress of our project. Along with this interview, we will take before and after photos to document the renovations. We are excited to share these updates and hope you are, too.

Finally, thank you to everyone who made our HMS Open House on March 20, 2024, to celebrate the history of our building. It was terrific to hear all of the stories about what school was like for families over the years and about the transformation of our building. Thank you to the Holmen Area Historical Society for helping plan the open house and providing some amazing historical documents. Thank you to our Holmen Community for all your support so we can renovate our HMS. I look forward to all the amazing memories we will create in our newly renovated building.

# **ATTENDANCE REMINDERS**

Attendance at school is essential to the successful completion of an education. Good communication from the school to the home and from the home to the school regarding absences is a major responsibility for the school and the home. Part of the school's mission is to teach students good work habits, which includes regular attendance.

All attendance matters (signing in or out, special leave requests, passes to leave school, reporting absences, etc.) are handled at the attendance desk. The attendance desk is located in the main office inside the Door D entrance.

- Please report all absences by 7:30 a.m. by calling the attendance line at 526-1369. If we do not hear from you, we will attempt to contact you to verify the absence. If no contact occurs, the absence will be considered unexcused.
- If your child needs to leave school during the school day: To avoid interruptions to the classroom we ask that you send a note with your student in the morning. They should bring the note to the attendance desk before school starts in the morning and we will issue them a pass to leave class. When it is time for them to leave, it is the student's responsibility to report to the attendance desk and wait for you to sign them out. Upon returning to school, the student is to sign in at the attendance desk to obtain a pass to return to class.
- If your child arrives late for school: Please send a note with your child or call (526-1369) so we can excuse him/her. Upon arrival he/she should report to the attendance desk to sign in and get a pass for class.
- Homework requests: If you wish to request homework, please leave that
  message when you call in your child's absence. Your child can also check his/her
  homework from their Chromebook.


