

PAIR READING STRATEGY

This strategy provides emergent readers with an enjoyable, successful experience and builds vocabulary.

- Choose books with predictable words and/or repeated phrases.
- Encourage your child to read along with you.
- Read the story, moving your finger under the words.
- Pause before familiar phrases or predictable words and encourage your child to say them with you.
- Ask your child to say the phrases himself/herself once they become familiar.
- Keep it fun and stress free!
- Encourage your child to say familiar words with you while reading other books.
- After reading the book, talk about the story and any new words
