Specialists in the early childhood field will provide families with information regarding:

- Children's typical growth and development
- The child's current level of development
- Services and resources available in the community for families and young children
- Any questions or concerns parents may have pertaining to their child
- Free vision and hearing screenings are also available

When does the screening take place?

- September 26th – 8:00 a.m. – 10:30 a.m. or 1:00 p.m. – 3:30 p.m.
- October 25th – 2:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.
- January 23rd – 8:00 a.m. – 10:30 a.m. or 1:00 p.m. – 3:30 p.m.
- March 26th – 2:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.
- May 15th – 8:00 a.m. – 10:30 a.m. or 1:00 p.m. – 3:30 p.m.

* Screenings take approximately 20 minutes and parents remain with their child throughout the screening process.
