MATH FACTS

Almost all of our students are struggling with math facts. Math facts are the basic computations we use in daily math contents. They are mostly one and two-digits and are in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Examples are 4+6, 2+8, 10–5, 20–3, 6x7, 10x0, 18÷2, and 6÷3. Being fluent with math facts will help students become automatic in knowing basic math skills. This will help them be able to learn new math concepts easier. This is especially important as the students go onto the next grade level where math will get harder.

Please help your student(s) practice math facts at home. Being consistent with practice will help these skills stick. If you need resources such as flash cards or even iPad games, please let me know and I can certainly send some home or find the right fit for your child(ren).
