1. Blankets, 1st shipment, Sold
 - a. Supposed to get them this week
 - i. #1 - Sold 22
 - ii. #2 - Sold 54
 - b. We will have 200 in inventory - 100 of each blanket
 - c. Find storage space for blankets that is not the PTO shed
2. Mini Grant-
 - a. EA's- Rolling cart - cost \$190
 - i. Approved
 - b. Opera for the young \$800
 - i. Mrs. Robinson here to discuss
 - ii. Based out of Madison - music performance degree. This years show is Beauty and the Beast. Exposure to musical theater.
 - iii. Fits in with Wisconsin Standards
 - iv. They send a curriculum ahead of time so the kids can learn ahead of time
 - v. Can come anytime - look at February for timing

- vi. Price is valid through November 30th - after that it goes up to \$900
