Treasurer Report: Betsy stated all account balance of \$4,200.00. We are still expecting a \$159 check from the Loggers Fundraiser. We spent \$200 on the food vouchers at Open House, and \$22 on the freezies for the playground grand opening. We briefly shared high expectations for the Spiritwear results, noting higher sales that usual (probably to new staff!)

Principal's Report: The Open House went really well. Kelly attested the teachers love having the food trucks and vouchers. The grand opening of the playground went really well, too – he thanked the PTG for the effort and support. We also approved a donation to the DARE program, our PTG logo will go on their shirts as well. This donation from the PTG is \$100. Betsy will take care of this.
