Secretary's Report:

- Minutes from the February PTG Meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report:

- Our account balance is \$6,653.30.
- Upcoming expenses include (amounts are estimates): birthday books (\$375), reading prize (\$20), teacher meal (\$300), sundae supplies (\$50).
- We received the fundraising check from Burrachos for \$126.99.

Principal's Report:

- The Kwik Books system continues to go relatively well. Three additional squishmallow prizes have been ordered. There is a reward system in place for the class that submits the most reading logs. There will be a special event held at the end of the year for students who have participated every month; so far, there are approximately 30 students who have done so. A conversation occurred about the Kwik Books "calendar" and if it could/should be simplified.
- Interviews for the Sand Lake School Psychologist position will occur 3/4/25; Anna will represent PTG.
- The Music Programs will be held:
 - 3/6/25 for 1st and 5th graders.
 - 3/18/25 for Kindergartners and 3rd graders.
- This Friday (3/7/25), there will be a special assembly for Read Across America Week. PTG will volunteer, intermittently, starting at 1:30. They will provide the list of ice cream sundae supplies as well as ice cream sandwiches for the students.
 - Anna will bring in ice cream sandwiches and chocolate chips.
 - Heidi will bring in remaining ice cream sundae supplies.
- Parent-Teacher conferences are scheduled for 3/11/25 and 3/13/25. Parents have been asked to sign up to bring desserts. The Book Fair will occur then as well.
- Forward Testing (for 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders) begins 3/17 and goes until the end of April.
- Voting for the School District of Holmen's Operational Referendum will occur 4/1/25. This referendum differs from the previous referendum in that it focuses on district services and programming. The previous referendum focused on building projects.
- There will be a full-day school celebration for Earth Day 4/16/25.

New Business:
