McIntosh apples are small to medium sized. Their skin is both red and green. It feels smooth and clean but it's tough to bite through! The inner flesh is tender, fine textured, and white.

How Does it Taste?

McIntosh apples are soft and sweet/tart tangy. They are excellent for baking, saucing, and cider! Apple sauce is even a fantastic and healthy substitute for oil in baked goods!

How Is It Grown?

The McIntosh apple trees at Ecker's are very large, standard sized trees. Some are up to 20 feet tall! The apples are color picked every fall, meaning we only pick the ripest and reddest apples each week in September!
