

Homebound Process

- **When to initiate homebound**
 - If the length of school missed is likely to exceed 20 days
 - If the student's absence is due to a medically diagnosed condition

- **Documentation needed before initial meeting**
 - Parent request for Homebound (in writing) to the building administrator
 - Physician's letter (Exhibit 1 in District Policy 342.2)

- **After documentation is received, hold initial meeting**
 - Called by administration (Principal or AP)
 - Attendees: Administrator (Principal or AP), case manager, nurse, Homebound Coordinator, parents, general education teacher, counselor (if not case manager)
 - Determine what subject needs to be taught
 - Determine if PLATO or a single course that can be purchased from the WI Virtual School would be appropriate
 - Determine whether or not to go to a SPED referral
 - Is it something that merits specialized instruction?
 - Will it be long-term?
 - Is it life-changing?
 - Will it affect learning?
 - If it crosses your mind that it might be a disability it's our obligation to refer
 - Write educational plan (see Exhibit 2 in District Policy 342.2)
 - Determine method of grading
 - Non-SPED
 - Just grade what they do in the subject chosen and exempt the rest
 - Make sure to include grading in the educational plan
 - SPED
 - Add "Modified Grades" to IEP and put Homebound in the comments

- **Homebound instruction meeting**
 - Prior to the meeting the Homebound Coordinator (District) will post for the position and communicate that the student needs homebound instruction and the subject.
 - Meeting will be set up by case manager
 - Attendees: Parent, case manager (counselor if non-IEP, case manager if IEP), homebound teacher
 - Admin not necessary unless needed
 - Go over the educational plan and have parents sign it
 - Let the parents share more detailed information with the homebound teacher
 - Determine place homebound will occur
 - Determine schedule (days and times) homebound will occur
 - Determine time, place and date for meeting the next month
 - Determine how and when the homebound instructor will get assignments and bring them back to the teacher for grading
