PBIS is a process that ensures all students are respectful, responsible, and safe while at school.

It is the implementation of the best evidence-based academic and behavioral practice for improving academic and behavioral outcomes.

It is a process that focuses on improving a school's ability to teach and support positive behavior for ALL students, ALL staff, and in ALL settings.

## Our Acknowledgement System

In the spirit of "Viking Expectations", classrooms are working together to reach a school wide goal.

Individuals or classes can earn acknowledgements or treasure tickets from staff throughout the building for demonstrating positive behavior.

When a classroom reaches their treasure ticket goal, a jewel is posted on our school-wide bulletin board located outside the office.

Once the school has reached the desired goal, a school wide celebration will take place to acknowledge the positive work of our students.
